Dear Patients,

As most of you already know, I am retiring this Spring and closing the practice – at the end of March 2023. I tried to break the news to everyone in person as much as I could over the last few months, but there remain some whom I won't be able to see before it's too late to give adequate notice and recommendations to, so to be on the safe side I'm sending out his notice.

I am grateful for having had the opportunity to have gotten to know each and every one of you over the years, and to help you in what way that I could – at least I hope I helped.

As far as recommendations, there's only one small group of Neurologists in town that I know really - Western Neuro. LTD. - as most everyone else has left town or retired themselves. They are just across the street here and serve St. Joes mostly. The specific docs there are Dr. Rod Anderson – General Neurology, and Dr. Diana Benenati – who subspecializes in neuromuscular, but also does general, and then there's Dr. Kendra Drake - who subspecializes in seizure disorders, but also does general. For Parkinson's specifically I would recommend Dr. Cynthia Reed – she's not with Western Neuro, but on her own – and only sees Parkinson's. Then there's always other practices around town like the UofA, and CNS, and a NW group I'm not really familiar with, and perhaps there's still some solo-practice dinosaurs like me out there too – I'm not sure. I would also check your Insurance Co. to see who they contract with preferentially – which may be a limiting factor in this age of the 'Medical Industrial Complex' control of medicine.
